A lifelong resident here, Miss Gillmore was a member of the First Reformed Church and a former member of its Woman's Guild.

She is survived by a cousin, Mrs. Elsie R. Case of New Brunswick.

Private funeral services will be at 2 p.m. tomorrow in the Quackenboss Funeral Home, 156 Livingston Ave., with the Rev. David Muyskens, pastor of the First Reformed Church, officiating.

Burial will be in Elmwood Cemetery, North Brunswick.

There will be no calling hours.

The funeral of William H. Price of 77 Livingston avenue, who died yesterday morning in New York will be held Friday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home of Mrs. Ross Johnson at Belle View Farm, River road, a niece of the deceased.

The Rev. Daniel Y. Brink, pastor of the First Reformed Church, will have charge of the services. Interment will be in the family plot in Elmwood Cemetery under the direction of Undertaker William H. Quackenboss and Son.

Mr. Price was in business on Burnet street for many years, having succeeded his father, the late H. M. Price, who had continued the trade begun by his father, James Price.

An active member of the Democratic party, he served in several important political positions. He was a charter member of the P. O. Elks lodge, No. 324.

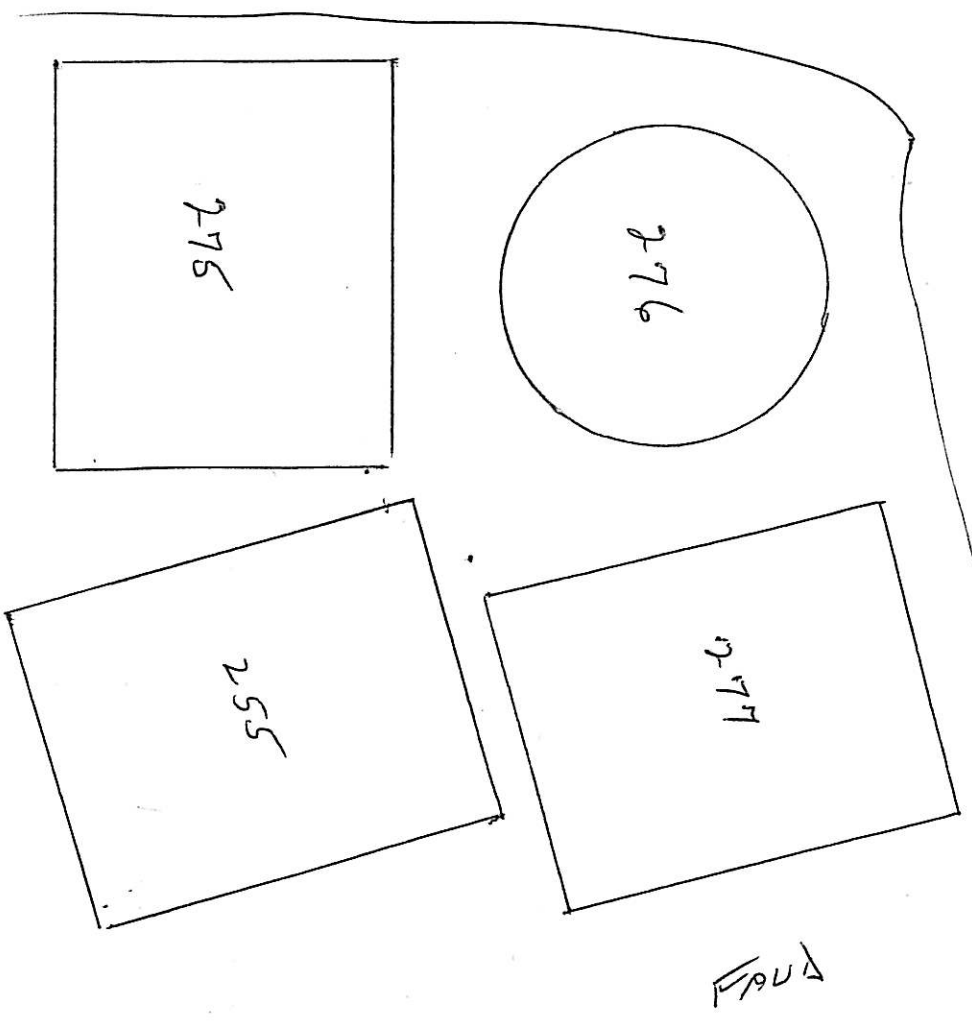

Obituary.

This morning Mrs. Abigail N. Price, the beloved wife of Mr. Henry N. Price, died at her residence on Burnet street of liver troubles, in the 69th year of her age. Mrs. Price had been ill for some time. She was a member of the Second Presbyterian Church and had lived in this city nearly all her life. She was eminently a home body and her disposition was so kindly that she won a host of friends, who sincerely mourn the loss of one who was so dear to them. Besides her husband, (six) children are left to mourn a loss which is irreparable. They are Elizabeth, wife of Judge Jonathan Dixon, James, Henry C., Wm. H. and Benj. Price, and Laura, wife of Gregory Gilmore. All reside in this city except Mrs. Dixon, who arrived here a short time before her mother expired.

The funeral will take place from the residence of her husband, 255 Burnet street, at 2 o'clock on Tuesday afternoon.
